Grief and Loss in Today's Schools with Gen Nelson MS, LPC, NCC

Morning Session:

As school counselors, how are we serving our grieving students? Participants will dive deeper into understanding grief and all of its complications in today's world. Through an overview of new and former grief work theories, participants will be able to better understand the needs of the bereaved, while examining the societal stigmas and barriers many grievers experience. Discussion topics will include: appropriate grief terminology, secondary losses, suicide loss, Prolonged Grief Disorder (DSM-V-TR), and the complications of death due to COVID19.

Afternoon Session:

What do we do with all of this information? Participants will be given resources and tools to help their students on their grief journeys in both the individual and small group settings. Recommended group structures and formats will be discussed. Examples and supplies will be given for specific activities for participants to take, adapt, and use with students immediately.
